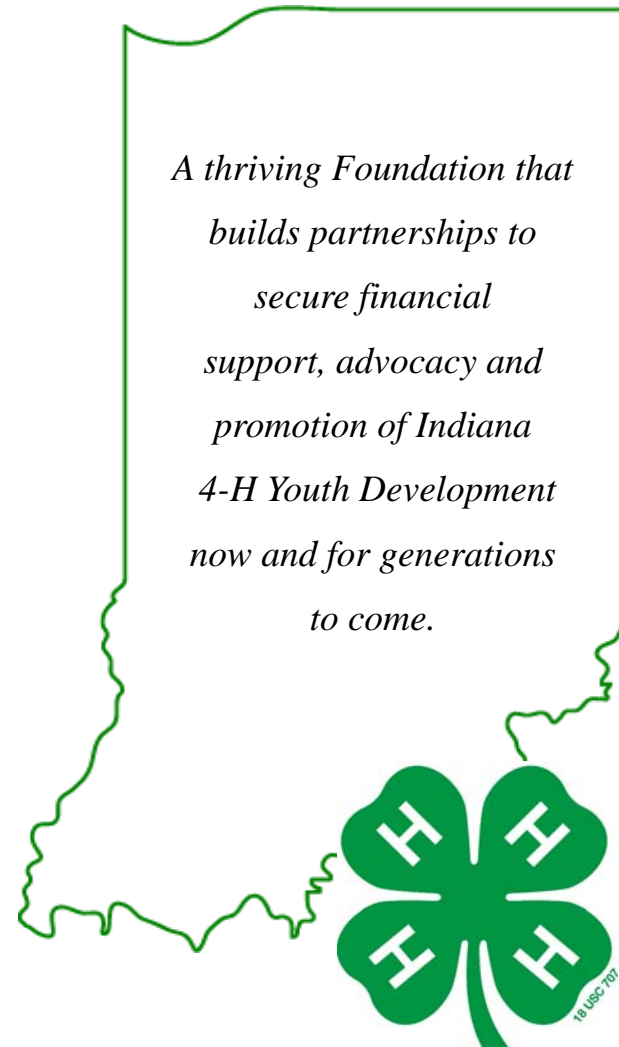

The Foundation

Since 1961, the Indiana 4-H Foundation has provided support to 4-H youth and volunteers through programs statewide including:

- Publications for Indiana 4-H Programs
- Promotion of the value of the 4-H experience
- Adult volunteer recognition

The Indiana 4-H Foundation's success depends on the generosity of donors and volunteers to supply the resources necessary to fund and maintain programs for more than 300,000 4-H youth statewide.

The Foundation seeks to further its mission by providing support for both youth and adult leader programs in all 92 counties through grants made to individual county and local programs. In addition, the Foundation provides key support for statewide leadership and youth development programs through annual events including Indiana 4-H Congress, 4-H Roundup and Junior Leader Conference.

Since its establishment in 1961, the Foundation has granted over \$6 million in support of Indiana 4-H youth, volunteers and programs.
